It's Bush!

Voters give vice president a promotion; Dukakis is a big loser in Electoral College

Vice President George Bush was elected the nation's 41st President on Tuesday, sweeping past Michael Dukakis to assure four more years of Republican rule in the White House. Democrats countered with decisive control of both houses of Congress.

"I mean to be a president of all the people," the president-elect said as he received the verdict in his adopted hometown of Houston. Asked when he would get down to the work of forming a government, he replied, "Tomorrow."

Bush was winning the popular vote by 54 percent to 46 percent and he led by miles in the Electoral College.

It was a triumph for the Republican Party and for his vanquished opponent, Democrat Michael Dukakis.

"We can now speak the most majestic words a democracy has to offer: the people have spoken," Bush said in victory remarks at a GOP rally in Houston. "With a full heart and great hopes I thank all the people throughout America who have given us this great victory."

He said he meant to be president of all the people, and expressed his goal for an "America that is strong and resolute in the world, strong and big-hearted."

Initial estimates said turnout was scarcely above 50 percent, close to a 40-year low.

In the popular vote, with 78 percent of the precincts reporting, Bush had 32,361,104 or 54 percent. Dukakis had 23,691,104 or 46 percent for Dukakis. It wasn't close where it counted, in the electoral votes. Bush won 37 states for 352 electoral votes and led for 74. Dukakis won 9 states and the District of Columbia for 102 electoral votes and led for 10 as the vote counts moved toward the Pacific Coast.

Bush made his first public appearance as president-elect in a nationally televised rally before supporters in Texas.

"We can now speak the most majestic words a democracy has to offer: the people have spoken," Bush said in victory remarks at a GOP rally in Houston. "With a full heart and great hopes I thank all the people throughout America who have given us this great victory."

He said he meant to be president of all the people, and expressed his goal for an "America that is strong and resolute in the world, strong and big-hearted."

Andrus sells Centennial plate to Stara Haslip to note receipt of award

Some people purchasing Centennial license plates Monday found a familiar face behind the counter — Gov. Cecil Andrus.

At least one found a bargain as well. Andrus told customer Stara Haslip that he would float her a loan to pay for her new plate, the 88,888th sold since the Centennial edition was issued. He autographed the plate as "senior clerk of the office."

Andrus put in a stint behind the counter to help celebrate the anniversary of a national collectors' society. The communications firm was designed by Ruth Rydard/Duane, is embossed with a mountain and white birch bark design.

The commission also has funded a collection of Idaho folk songs, compiled by Mervyn Rossie/Sorenson. Many members of the New France tribe acted as extras in the film "The First Man in the West" — in 1903, when the tribe was still in the area.
