RE: Application for Idaho Airport Aid Program (IAAP)
Project Funding for State Fiscal Year 2015 (SFY-15)

The purpose of this announcement is to invite your application for State of Idaho grant funds available for SFY-15 (July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015). In order to be considered for a grant from the Idaho Airport Aid Program the Airport Owner MUST submit an application to the Division of Aeronautics.

Primary Service airports may request State funding assistance for the cost of planning, maintenance and/or upgrade of existing facilities. State funding consists of a lump sum amount based upon the total amount of Aeronautics fund revenue. There are two options for making an application. (1) Primary Service airports that request IAAP funds to match a FAA-AIP grant MUST submit a full and complete copy of the federal application for assistance (IDAPA 39.04.04 Section 300.05b). (2) Primary Service airports that request IAAP funds, not associated with a FAA-AIP grant, MUST submit the attached IAAP application for funding assistance. Please refer to the attached instructions for project eligibility.

Reliever and General Aviation airports may request State funding assistance for the cost of planning, maintenance and upgrade of existing facilities. There are two options for making an application. (1) Reliever and General Aviation airports that request IAAP funds to match a FAA-AIP grant MUST submit a full and complete copy of the federal application for assistance (IDAPA 39.04.04 Section 300.05b). State funding consists of up to fifty percent (50%) of the sponsor's required match (IDAPA 39.04.04 Section 300.02e). (2) Reliever and General Aviation airports that request Small Emergency Projects grant funding assistance MUST use the attached application form. This program provides less than two thousand dollars (\$2,000) annually for unscheduled or emergency repairs or equipment on the airport. Please refer to the attached instructions for project eligibility.

PLEASE NOTE: Aeronautics funds for airport grants are limited because they are dependent upon actual revenues deposited into the aeronautics fund. When actual revenues are below projections the Division must delay or withhold a grant offer. The deadline for submitting this IAAP application to the Division of Aeronautics is:

5:00 pm, Friday, June 27, 2014.
