Broadway Avenue Bridge Replacement

Why Replace the Bridge?

The Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) is replacing the Broadway Bridge over the Boise River and improving Broadway Avenue from University Drive to Front Street.

The Broadway Bridge is being replaced because the existing structure:

- Is more than 50 years old and does not meet today's standards.
- Has outlived its service life.
- Can no longer accommodate today's high volume of cars, pedestrians and bicyclists.



Project Description

The need to replace the Broadway Bridge has provided ITD with an opportunity to make many improvements to Broadway Avenue. The project includes:

- Removing and replacing the bridge.
- Rebuilding Broadway Avenue from University Drive to Front Street.
- Improving bicycle and pedestrian facilities from University Drive to Front Street.
- Enhancing connectivity from the Greenbelt pathway to Broadway Avenue.

The new Broadway Bridge will have a 75-year design life and meet the current and future needs of our community.
