UPDATE**

Demolition of Broadway Avenue Bridge is underway

January 5, 2016

Over the next 20 days, crews will break apart and remove the Broadway Bridge section-by-section.

Neighbors can expect to hear **increased noise levels** from heavy equipment, back-up alarms, jackhammers and breaking of concrete from **7 a.m. to 7 p.m.**



Crews are working 24/7. A **construction camera** of the work zone has been set up at <http://ibeamsystems.com/private/idbroadway/>. The camera updates every ten minutes.

Once the existing structure is demolished, work will begin to construct the new Broadway Bridge. The project is expected to be complete this fall.

REMINDER:

Broadway Avenue at the Boise River is now an active and restricted construction zone.
