## Watch for traffic control and oversize loads as girders arrive for the new Broadway Bridge

March 16, 2016



*Through mid-April crews will set 30 steel girders for the new Broadway Bridge.*

**Crews will begin setting girders** for the new Broadway Avenue Bridge on **Thursday** (Mar. 17). The girders will be delivered via Broadway Avenue and Myrtle Street.

- **Expect traffic control on Broadway Avenue and Myrtle Street** as oversize loads bring girders into the work zone.
- **Intermittent rolling slowdowns** will occur on Interstate 84 in east Boise and on I-184 (Connector) to accommodate the oversize loads.
- **The girders will be brought into the work zone** at the north entrance, near Myrtle Street, and at the south entrance, near University Drive.

The girder-placement process will extend through mid-April.

on ITD's 24/7 work zone camera. The camera updates every 10 minutes.

In all, 30 steel girders are being placed to support the deck of the new Broadway Bridge. From end to

end, the girders measure about 422 feet long.
