PARDON OUR NOISE

January 12, 2016

Over the next four to six weeks, the contractor will be building the foundation for the new Broadway Bridge. Crews will be hammering steel beams into the ground which will be **very noisy.**

Pile driving will occur **seven days a week** from **7 a.m. to 7 p.m.**

Drivers and surrounding neighbors will hear **high noise volumes** during this work, as pile driving is very loud.



What is pile driving?

Pile driving is a common construction activity in which steel beams are driven into the ground. The piles will support the bridge foundation. For this project, 168 piles are being hammered deep into the river bed.

REMINDER:

The **Boise River** through the Broadway Bridge Replacement project construction zone **is closed for the next several months.** The work zone needs to be restricted to safely remove and demolish the existing bridge.
