



CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

Broadway Interchange will operate as a single-point urban interchange Tuesday morning (June 30)

June 26, 2015

The new traffic signal at the I-84 Broadway Avenue Interchange will be turned on by **5 a.m. Tuesday morning (June 30)**.

- **Broadway Avenue will be reduced to one lane in each direction from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. on Monday night (June 29)** while crews activate the signal.
- **Flaggers will direct traffic** Monday night during work on the signal.



Once it is in operation, the signal will control all turns through the Broadway Interchange from a central point. This configuration is called a **single-point urban interchange**, or a **SPUI**.

Lane restrictions in the area will continue on Broadway Avenue through the summer while crews finish paving the area and rebuilding the roadway between the New York Canal and TA Travel Center.

BROADWAY INTERCHANGE CONSTRUCTION SUMMER 2015 UPDATE

Crews will widen Broadway Avenue between the New York Canal and the TA Travel Center while continuing to build the new I-84 Broadway Interchange.


Construction is on schedule to be complete late this year.



Traffic will begin using the new single-point urban interchange (SPUI). The SPUI will be similar to the interchange at Vista Avenue. **See reverse to learn more about a SPUI.**

JUNE – JULY

- Traffic will continue to use the east side of Broadway Avenue.
- Southbound Broadway Avenue will be reduced to one lane over the interchange bridge.



JULY – AUGUST

- Traffic will be shifted to the west side of Broadway Avenue.
- Southbound Broadway Avenue will remain reduced to one lane over the interchange bridge.
- Drivers will be shifted onto the permanent ramps of the new interchange. Lane configurations on the ramps will continue to be adjusted through this fall.



Interstate 84 is open to three lanes in each direction at the Broadway Interchange.

ITD reminds drivers the work zone speed limit is 25 mph on Broadway Avenue.

Overnight lane restrictions will be in place from 8:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. weekdays and 7 a.m. weekends.

DRIVING THE NEW BROADWAY INTERCHANGE

The new I-84 Broadway Avenue Interchange is designed as a Single-Point Urban Interchange (SPUI). It has a single traffic signal that controls all movements through the interchange from a center point.

The final configuration you see below will be complete late this summer.
