The I-84 Simco Road Interchange project located at Milepost 74.374, in Elmore County will replace the interchange which is currently in poor condition and is structurally deficient. Ramps will be upgraded to meet the standards for the 80 MPH speed limit.

The I-84 Blacks Creek Interchange project located at Milepost 63.541, in Ada County will replace the interchange which is currently in poor condition and is structurally deficient. Ramps will be upgraded to meet the standards for the 80 MPH speed limit.

Work to be performed by Consultant:

- Preliminary Design
- Traffic Control Design & Plans.
- Geotechnical investigation of the project area.
 - Collect pavement and geotechnical information plus testing sufficient to calculate required paving section and investigation of bridge foundations.
- Materials Phase Reports.
 - Phase I (A) Rehabilitation for Pavement Report with a Life Cycle Cost Analysis.
 - Combined Phase II/III Materials Reports
 - **Phase IV Materials Report**
 - Phase V Materials Report
- Final Design
