

St. Maries River Railroad Co. & St. Joe River BRIDGE REPLACEMENTS

OVERVIEW

The Design-Build Team of RSCI, Inc. and J-U-B ENGINEERS, Inc. will design and reconstruct new bridges over the St. Maries River Railroad Company tracks and the St. Joe River. This work will include:

- **RAILROAD BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION:**

- Two travel lanes
- Sidewalks
- Shoulders/bike lanes

- **RIVER BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION:**

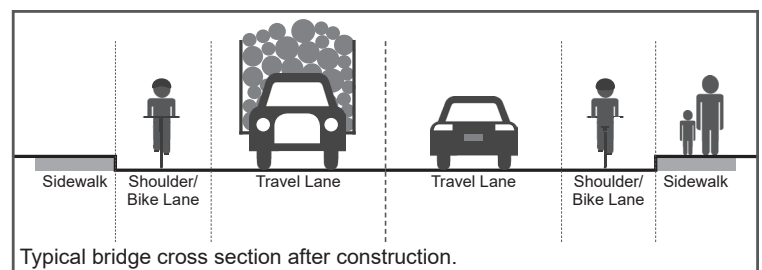
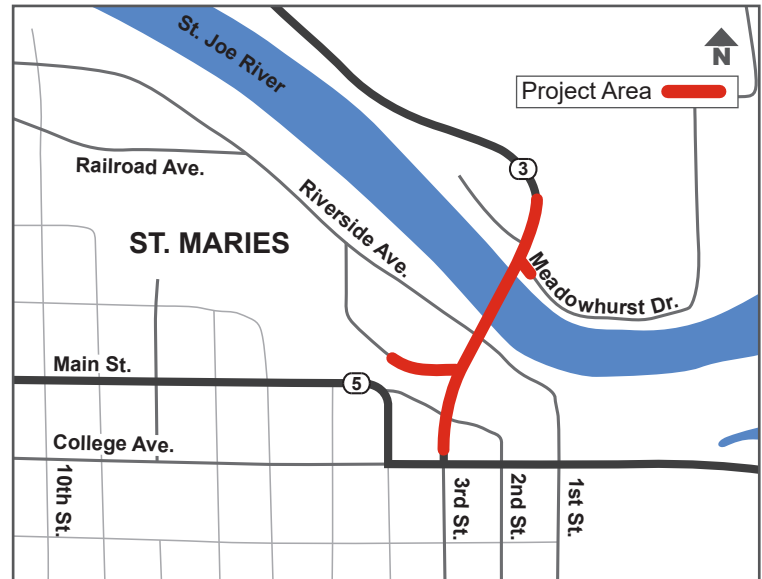
- Two travel lanes
- Sidewalks
- Shoulders/bike lanes

- **OVERALL IMPROVEMENTS ALONG ID-3 BETWEEN ID-5 (COLLEGE AVENUE) AND ED'S R&R CARWASH:**

- Resurfacing
- Signage improvements on ID-3
- Guardrail in several locations
- Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) pedestrian facilities
- Roadway drainage system improvements
- Intersection enhancements

- **ADDITIONAL IMPROVEMENTS:**

- Railroad Avenue resurfacing between ID-3 and 10th Street



The project will update the aging infrastructure, improve safety, enhance pedestrian facilities, and provide a smoother driving surface. The project kicked off in mid-July, and construction is scheduled to start in early fall 2017 and continue through spring 2019.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- **FALL 2017 THROUGH WINTER 2017:** Crews will remove and replace the railroad bridge.
- **WINTER 2017 THROUGH SUMMER 2018:** Crews will construct the west half of the new river bridge.
 - The road will be reduced to one lane with a temporary signal to direct traffic.
 - Delays up to fifteen minutes during peak hours can be expected.
 - A pedestrian pathway will be maintained.
- **SUMMER THROUGH WINTER 2018:** Crews will construct the east half of the new river bridge.
 - Two-way traffic will be shifted onto the new west side of the bridge.
 - A pedestrian pathway will be maintained.
- **WINTER 2018 THROUGH SPRING 2019:** Crews will perform final project work.
 - Intermittent traffic impacts.
- **GENERAL AND ONGOING IMPACTS:**
 - Crews will work during daylight hours Monday through Saturday and Sundays as needed.
 - Residents and businesses will experience occasional noise, dust and vibration during working hours.

Please note: construction schedules are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances.
