



The Idaho Transportation Department will resurface and reconstruct Idaho 44 between I-84 and the city of Star.

This winter, ITD will improve two irrigation pipes under Idaho 44 in Middleton and Star. Resurfacing will begin in the spring. Maintaining the roadway today will prevent more costly repairs in the future.

I-84 TO MIDDLETON

- Resurface the existing pavement.

MIDDLETON

- Excavate and remove the existing roadway material. Replace it with a new roadway surface.
- Add a westbound right-turn bay at Middleton Road and Hartley Lane.
- ★ Repair the pipe that carries irrigation water under Idaho 44, just west of Whiffen Lane.

MIDDLETON TO STAR

- Resurface the existing pavement.
- ★ Replace the pipe that carries irrigation water under Idaho 44, just east of Can-Ada Road.

STAR

- Excavate and remove the existing roadway material. Replace it with a new roadway surface.
- Rebuild curbs and sidewalks to meet requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act.

WHAT TO EXPECT


JANUARY 2017

In January, ITD will begin to repair the irrigation pipe at Whiffen Lane and replace the pipe at Can-Ada Road. During this work:

- Idaho 44 may be reduced to a single-lane at Whiffen Lane and Can-Ada Road for two weekends. A temporary signal will direct traffic.
- The speed limit will be reduced to 35 mph.
- Most work will be completed from 7 p.m. Friday to 6 a.m. Monday.
- Occasional lane restrictions may be necessary on week nights.
- Work will be weather dependent.

SPRING/SUMMER 2017

ITD will resurface and reconstruct the roadway. This work will require additional lane restrictions on Idaho 44. ITD will update you about the schedule and traffic impacts before construction.
