What to expect during construction:



- One lane will be open in each direction.
- Speed limit will be reduced.
- Shoulders will be restricted.
- Occasional single lane closures will be necessary. When lane closures are in place, flaggers will direct traffic.

The Gold Fork River Bridge Replacement Project includes:

- Removing and replacing the bridge
- Widening the new bridge to include:
 - Two 12-foot travel lanes (one in each direction)
 - 10-foot shoulder on each side
- Paving the roadway approaches on both sides of the bridge

Construction Sequencing:

MAY TO EARLY SUMMER


- Building a temporary bridge west of the existing structure to keep traffic moving during construction.

SUMMER

- Switching traffic to the temporary bridge.
- Demolishing the old bridge.
- Building the new bridge foundation.

FALL

- Building the bridge deck.
- Paving the roadway approaches and completing the bridge.
- Switching traffic onto the new bridge.
- Removing the temporary bridge.
