

U.S. 93, 100 South Intersection

The Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) is completing early development and preliminary design for the future project to reconstruct U.S. 93 through the 100 South Road intersection in Jerome County. The project is not currently funded for construction.

Project Description

The project includes survey, roadway design, Right of Way plans (80% development), geotechnical, and utility plans. Design will be driven by the approved EA FONSI and include two travel lanes in each northbound and southbound directions with center turn lanes at one-mile intervals. A vegetated median will be designed to facilitate access control with right-in right-out at the half mile intervals. Intersection improvements will be coordinated with the Jerome Highway District. Intersection improvements to the SH-25 junction will need to be addressed, analyzed, and recommendations for consideration of future development will be needed.

Access to the highway will be restricted and controlled in compliance with findings of the EA to improve safety and capacity of the roadway. Land purchases will be necessary to facilitate the widening.

Construction of the project will depend on available funding in coming years.
