



CONSTRUCTION AHEAD – 2017

I-15 motorists near Fort Hall will see new traffic pattern Thursday

A new traffic pattern will take effect **Thursday, May 4** on I-15 between the Fort Hall Reservation Boundary and Burns Road. The Idaho Transportation Department reminds motorists to **slow down and pay attention** in the construction zone.

Effective Thursday, both northbound and southbound motorists will be on the southbound side of the interstate. One lane of traffic will be open in both directions.

This will allow crews to work on:

- Removing the existing pavement.
- Improving the clearance below the structures at the Railroad Overpass, Fort Hall Interchange and Sheepskin Road.
- Replacing guardrail.

Construction on the I-15 northbound lanes will take approximately a month to complete. Once northbound lanes are complete, crews will work on the southbound lanes. All work is expected to be complete this summer. [Click here](#) to download the project fact sheet.
