Replacement of overpass on Pancheri Drive south of RIGBY - Replacement of the Pancheri Drive overpass so Idaho Transportation Department announced. The bulk of travel on Pancheri Drive will be maintained at one lane in each direction. As construction advances, the public will be no construction will take place seven days a week.
