1. Justification

The approval of this section of SH 3 in conjunction with the approval of US 12 requested in a previous form, would connect Kendrick, ID and Bovill, ID with the rest of the 129,000 pound designated route network via US 95.

SH 13 is an essential route connecting US 95 and US 12 and thus Western Idaho with Western Montana.

2. Associated Economic Benefits

The approval of both of these stretches of highway will allow Doug Andrus Distributing to better serve the Idaho Transporation Departement in delivering road salt to different maintenance sheds.
