

# The Basics of Transportation Funding for ITD

April 2017

Yearly average funding for the Idaho Transportation Department boils down to three main sources:



30% - State Motor Fuel Tax



14% - Registration Fees



50% - Federal Government

*DMV, direct fees and miscellaneous sources comprise the remaining 6%.  
Excludes general-fund transfers and special limited-time funding changes.*

## What it pays for:

ITD is responsible for more than 12,300 lane miles of state highway and interstates and 2,000 bridges. Funding primarily pays for maintenance and construction on this system. ITD faces an annual shortfall of more than \$100M in funding needed to maintain the state's roads and bridges. Increased transportation funding helps close the gap.
