



Daytime flagging on Gowen Road throughout the week (Dec. 15 - 19)

Dec. 15, 2014

This week, **flaggers will direct traffic on Gowen Road during the day (9 a.m. to 3 p.m.)** between Eisenman Road and the westbound I-84 ramps. Crews will be working to:

- Place temporary pavement on the north side of Gowen Road between S. Eisenman and the westbound I-84 ramps.
 - Once the temporary pavement is in place, traffic will be shifted to the north side of Gowen Road so crews can begin rebuilding the south side of the roadway.
- Install temporary signals on Gowen Road at the intersections of S. Eisenman Road and the eastbound ramps.



These activities are weather dependent.

This work marks the start of rebuilding and widening Gowen Road from Federal Way to Eisenman Road.

Over the next year, Gowen Road will be widened to two through lanes in both directions, and a third lane will be added on the eastbound side of Gowen Road. The lanes will be wider than the existing lanes, and sidewalk, curb and bicycle lanes will be added.
