



Restrictions on Gowen Road at I-84 Wednesday, Thursday nights (Nov. 11 & 12) as new signal is installed

Nov. 10, 2015

This week, crews will install the structure for a [new traffic signal on Gowen Road](#) at the Interstate 84 westbound ramps.



- **Wednesday and Thursday** (Nov. 11 & 12), lanes will be restricted on Gowen Road between Federal Way and Eisenman Road from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m.**, and flaggers will control traffic.
- The **I-84 westbound off-ramp** at Gowen Road will be closed **Thursday** (Nov. 12) from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m.**

- **All lanes will remain open during the day.** Drivers may see crews working on the shoulders of Gowen Road near the I-84 ramps while the signal is being installed.

The new signal is expected to be in operation next week. As a reminder, the schedule for this work is weather dependent.

Remember to slow down, pay attention in the construction zone and be aware of the safety of construction workers.



FALL 2015 I-84, Gowen Interchange



The new I-84 Gowen Interchange improvements include:

- I-84 widened to three lanes in each direction between Broadway Avenue and Gowen Road
- New traffic signal at the westbound I-84 ramps with dual left-turn lanes for the westbound on-ramp
- Longer, wider I-84 on- and off-ramps to provide more room for merging
- Three through eastbound lanes and two through westbound lanes on Gowen Road
- Curb, gutter and sidewalks will be added to Gowen Road. A bicycle lane will be added to the north side
