



Eastbound I-84 detour at Meridian Interchange extended to Tuesday night (Aug. 5)

Due to equipment failure on Monday night, **eastbound I-84 will be closed at the Meridian Interchange again tonight (Aug. 5)** while the Idaho Transportation Department sets girders for the new interchange bridge.



- The closure will begin at 10 p.m. and end at 5 a.m.
- Traffic will be directed to exit and re-enter I-84 using the Meridian Interchange ramps.
- The detour will include closing the eastbound "loop" on-ramp on southbound Meridian Road. Flaggers will direct traffic to the eastbound on-ramp on northbound Meridian Road.

I-84 Restrictions

I-84 has been reduced to three lanes in both directions between Meridian and Five Mile roads. Drivers can expect **additional lane restrictions at night** (10 p.m. to 5 a.m., and until 7 a.m. on weekends). ITD is rebuilding the two outside lanes in both directions, improving the storm-sewer system and resurfacing the two inside lanes.
