



I-84 between Eagle Interchange and Five Mile Overpass will return to four lanes

December 5, 2014

Interstate 84 between **Eagle Interchange and Five Mile Overpass** will return to four lanes in both directions by **Monday morning (Dec. 8)**.



Over the next several days:

- Construction crews will remove old striping, move guardrail and restripe I-84 back to four lanes in each direction between the Eagle Interchange and Five Mile Overpass.
- Crews will work overnight from **10 p.m. to 7 a.m., Friday and Saturday (Dec. 5-6)** and **10 p.m. to 5 a.m. on Sunday (Dec. 7)** to complete the work.

These activities are weather dependent.

Both westbound and eastbound I-84 will remain four lanes until February 2015. ITD anticipates lane restrictions and a crossover traffic pattern will be put back in place on I-84 between Meridian and Five Mile.
