



I-84 between Meridian and Eagle interchanges will return to four lanes

Interstate 84 between **Meridian and Eagle interchanges** will return to four lanes in both directions by **Wednesday, Nov. 26**. Work will be rescheduled due to inclement weather.



Three lanes will remain in place on I-84 from the Eagle Interchange to Five Mile Road. In order to return this section to four lanes in each direction, crews need to pave the westbound shoulder and restripe the road. ITD anticipates reopening the fourth lane in this section later next week.

The crossover pattern was put in place in October to give crews room to rebuild the outside lanes of I-84. Crews have completed rebuilding the westbound side of I-84 between Five Mile and Cloverdale roads and rebuilding a culvert near the Eagle Interchange.

Both westbound and eastbound I-84 will remain open to four lanes of traffic until February 2015 when crews will resume work. At that time, lane restrictions and a crossover traffic pattern will be put back in place on I-84 between Meridian and Five Mile.
