



CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

Major changes at the Meridian Interchange and Meridian Road this weekend (June 26-28)

June 24, 2015

Over the weekend (June 26-28), drivers should plan for changes at the Meridian Interchange.



- The eastbound I-84 "loop" **on-ramp from southbound Meridian Road will be closed and removed.** The ramp will close at 10 p.m. on Friday night (June 26). This is to make way for a new longer and wider eastbound off-ramp.
 - **All motorists will still be able to access eastbound I-84 from Meridian Road using a temporary signal.**
- On Friday and Saturday nights (June 26 and 27), **Meridian Road will be reduced to one lane in each direction with flaggers** between Central Drive and Overland Road from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Crews will shifting traffic to the east.
- All **on- and off- ramps at Meridian Interchange will be shifted** to the north and **temporary signals will be installed.**

The work zone speed limit is 35 mph on Meridian Road and 55 mph on I-84. ITD urges drivers to leave early, slow down and pay attention.

MERIDIAN INTERCHANGE CONSTRUCTION SUMMER 2015 UPDATE


Crews will continue to build the new I-84 Meridian Interchange, improve Meridian Road and widen I-84 to four lanes. ITD reminds drivers the work zone speed limit is 55 mph on I-84 and 35 mph on Meridian Road. Construction is on schedule to be complete late this year.

Rebuild west side of Meridian Road

Traffic on Meridian Road is being shifted to the east between Central Drive and Overland Road. Meridian Road will be closed for one night between the I-84 ramps while crews install the signal structure.

Continue to widen I-84 to four lanes at the Meridian Interchange

Overnight lane restrictions will be in place from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. weekdays and 7 a.m. weekends.



Continue to build permanent on- and off-ramps

The eastbound "loop" on-ramp will be closed and removed. All traffic will enter eastbound I-84 from the ramp on the east side of Meridian Road. All ramps will be shifted to the north and temporary signals will be installed.
