



CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

Nighttime bridge work at Meridian Interchange means new lane restrictions, traffic shifts

Aug. 7, 2014

Nightly lane restrictions and traffic shifts will begin on I-84 tonight at the Meridian Interchange.

The restrictions are necessary for safety while construction crews tie rebar and form the deck for the interchange bridge



- From **10 p.m. to 5 a.m. during the next month, I-84 will be reduced to two lanes in both directions** under the interchange. The restrictions will continue until 7 a.m. on weekend mornings.
- The **eastbound "loop" on-ramp from southbound Meridian Road will be closed intermittently.** Drivers will be able to access the other eastbound on-ramp from northbound Meridian Road. Flaggers will direct traffic at the ramp intersection.
- Westbound I-84 will be reduced to one lane under the interchange for a few nights later this month.

The work zone will be different each night as crews work from one end of the bridge to the other. ITD reminds you to **slow down and pay attention** when driving through the area.
