UPDATE: Westbound I-84 crossover accelerated and scheduled to be in place by Tuesday (Oct. 7)

October 3, 2014

Work has been accelerated on westbound I-84 between Five Mile and Cloverdale roads.

- Starting Tuesday (Oct. 7), one lane of **westbound** I-84 will cross over to the **eastbound** side of the median between Five Mile and Cloverdale roads.
- The westbound crossover lane will be bordered with concrete barriers and barrels. **Motorists who choose to use this lane will not be able to exit at the Eagle Road Interchange.**
- Westbound drivers coming through the Wye Interchange will need to merge earlier than usual.

Drivers can expect to see crews working overnight on Monday and Tuesday as they prepare to put the crossover in place. Initiation of this work is weather dependent.

The eastbound I-84 crossover between Meridian and Cloverdale roads will be put in place by next weekend (Oct. 10-12). The crossovers will be in place until this winter.

Shifting traffic into crossovers will give crews room to rebuild the original

1960s outside lanes and shoulders of I-84.
