

Background

U.S. 20/26 is one of the few east-west roadways in the Treasure Valley that runs from Caldwell to Boise. It is currently a two-lane rural roadway with a 55 mph speed limit.

The land use along the roadway continues to change. There are an increasing number of residential subdivisions being constructed. The future is expected to bring a variety of development that will transform U.S. 20/26 into an urban corridor.

ITD wants to keep U.S. 20/26 functioning as a safe, primary east-west route in the future.
