WHEREAS, roadway incidents can occur at any time and often require police, firefighters, emergency medical services, tow companies and transportation workers; and

WHEREAS, when an emergency occurs, the prompt response of police, firefighters, emergency medical services, tow companies and transportation workers are critical to the protection of life and reduction of secondary crashes; and

WHEREAS, the safety of police, firefighters, emergency medical services, tow companies and transportation workers depends upon the training of the responders; and

WHEREAS, the traveling public must protect our responders by driving engaged and moving over when incident responders are present; and

WHEREAS, traffic incident management training affords the tools for responders to work together seamlessly by providing them with a single set of safety guidelines; and

WHEREAS, traffic incident responders in Idaho have contributed substantially to the treatment of patients, clearance of our roadways and increased mobility of the traveling public; and

WHEREAS, our responders have exhibited professionalism, cooperation and a sense of urgency while conducting their jobs;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C.L. "BUTCH" OTTER, Governor of the State of Idaho, do hereby proclaim November 11-17, 2018, to be

in Idaho, to honor the men and women whose diligence, effectiveness and proficiency keep our communities, roadways, and citizens safe.
