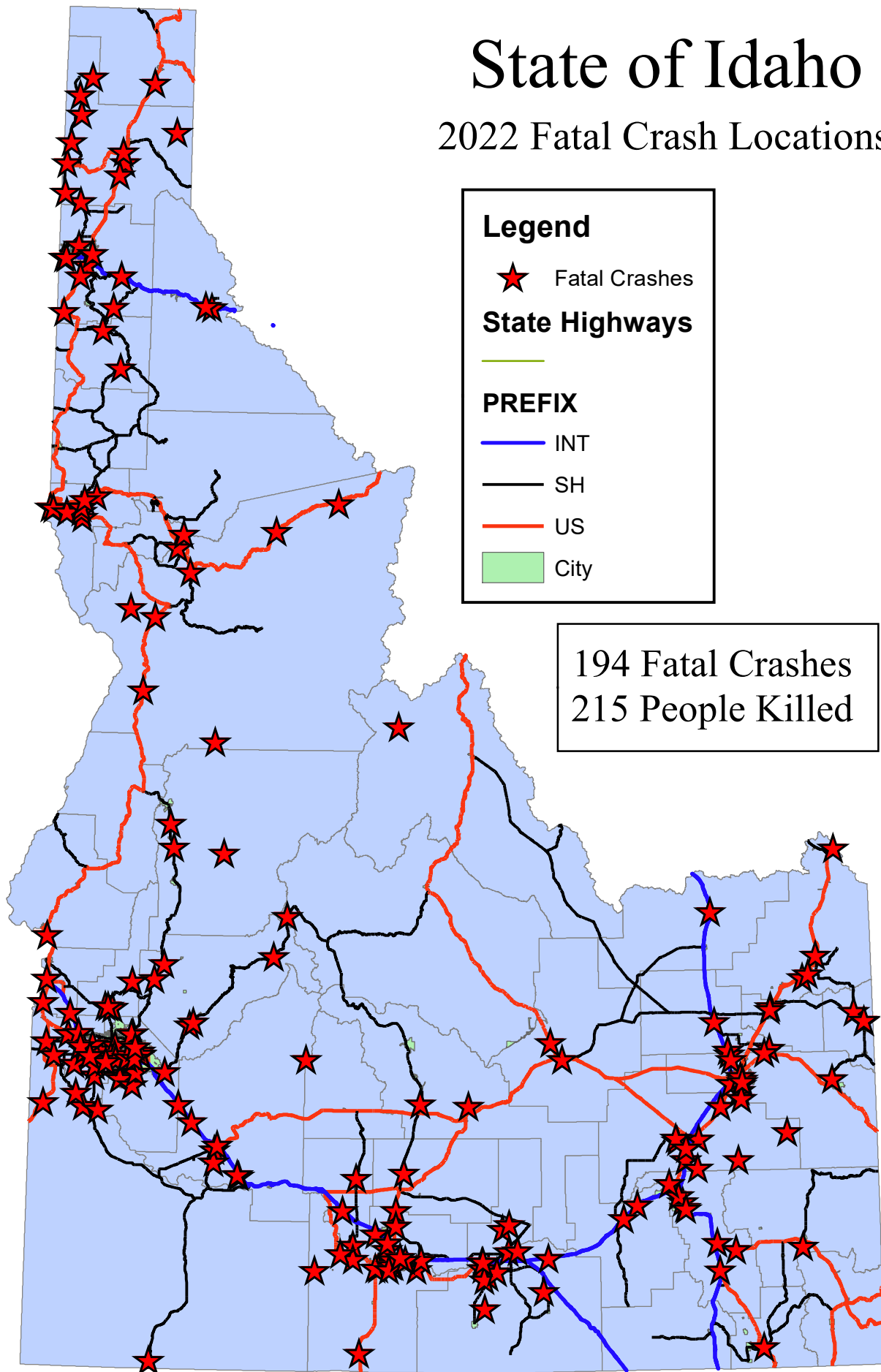


APPENDIX A: Maps of Fatal Crash Locations in 2022

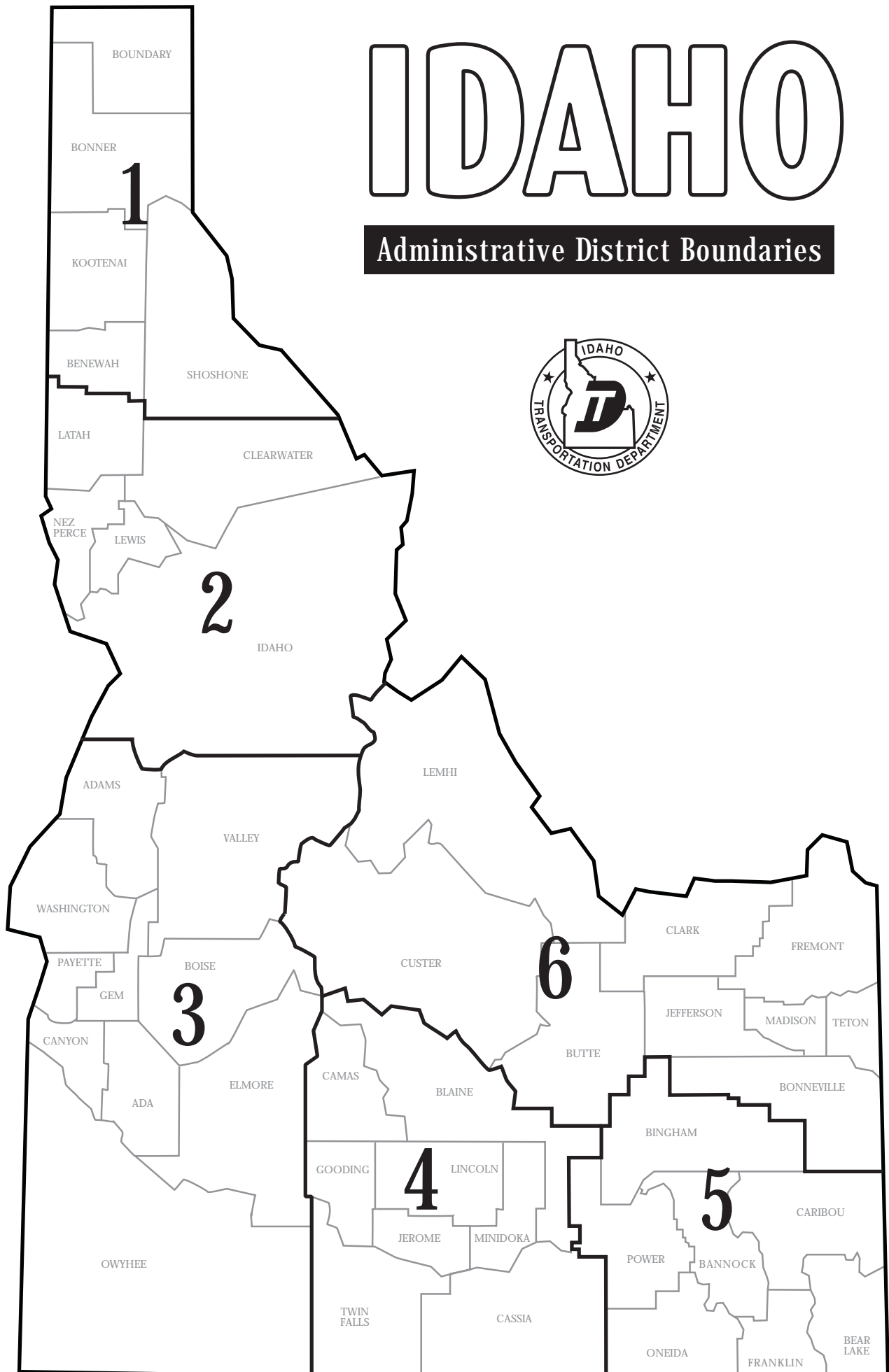

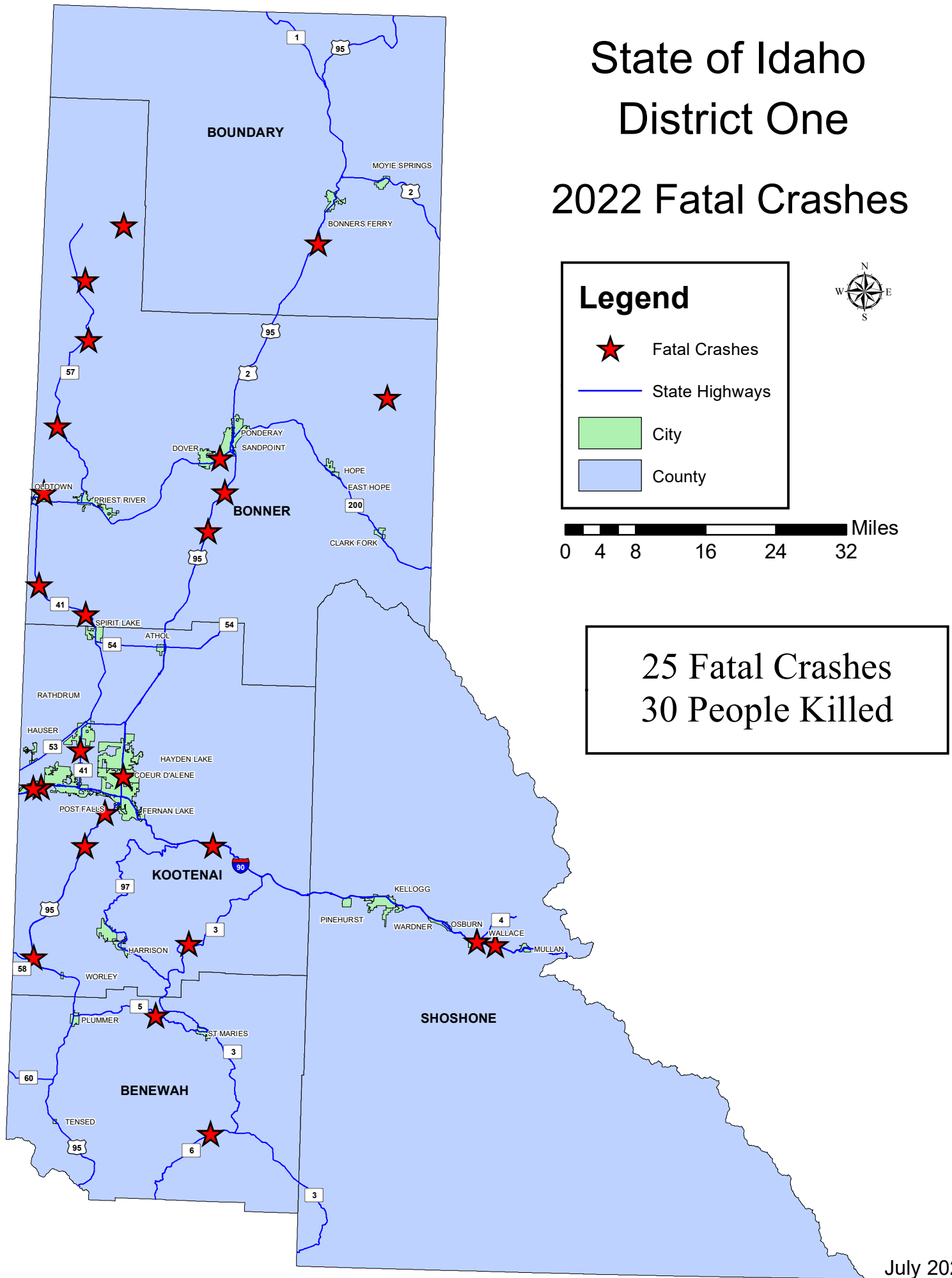
Administrative District Boundaries

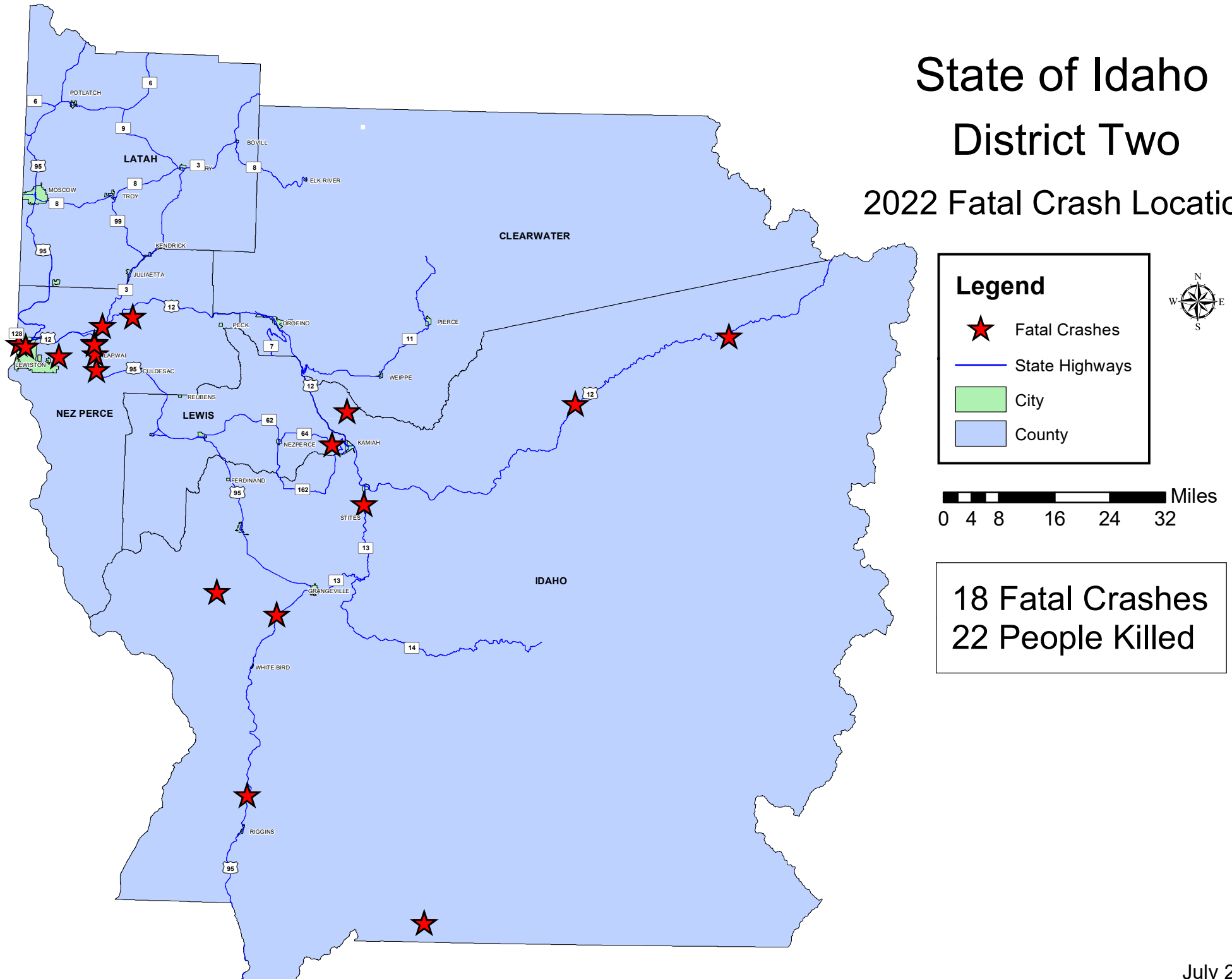

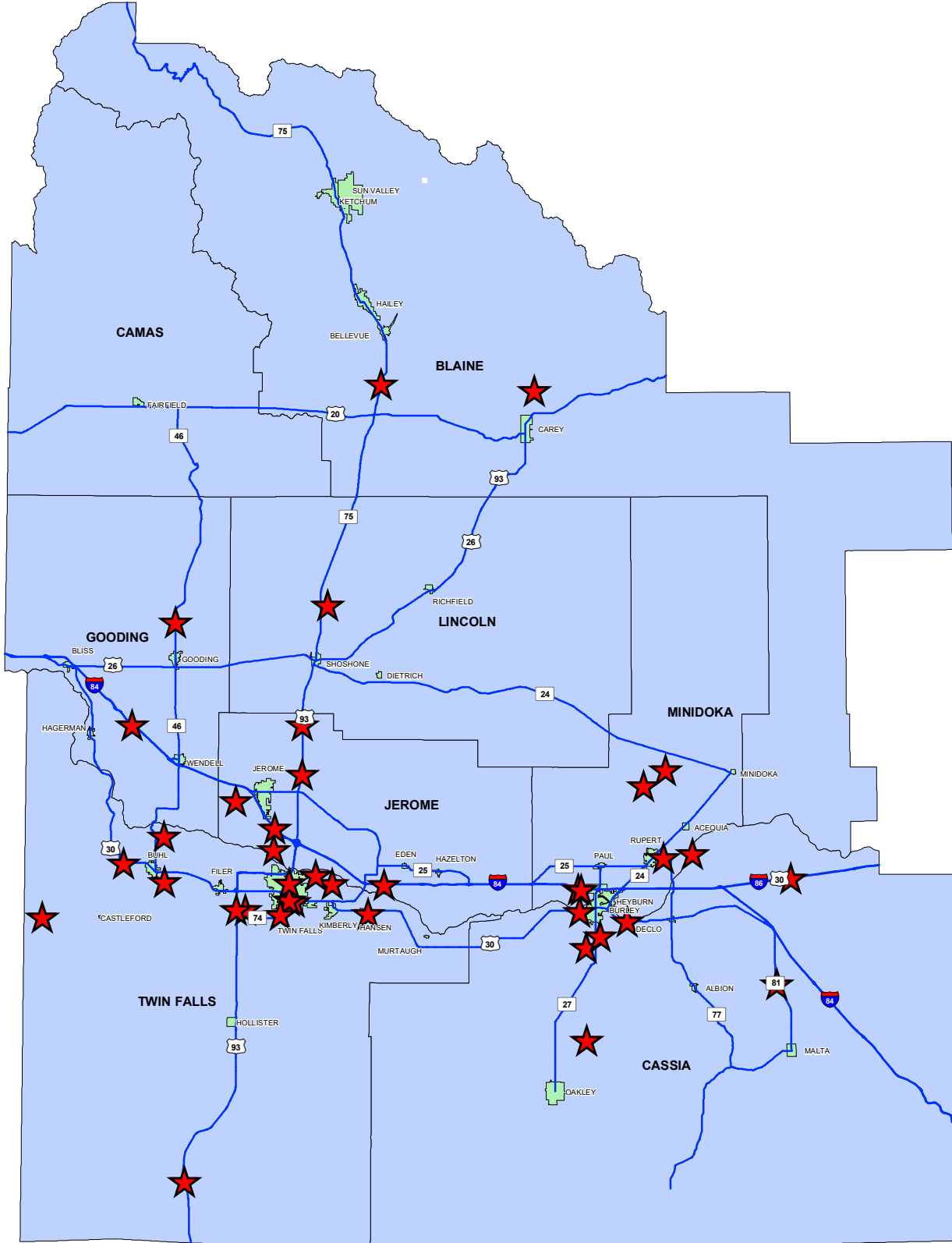

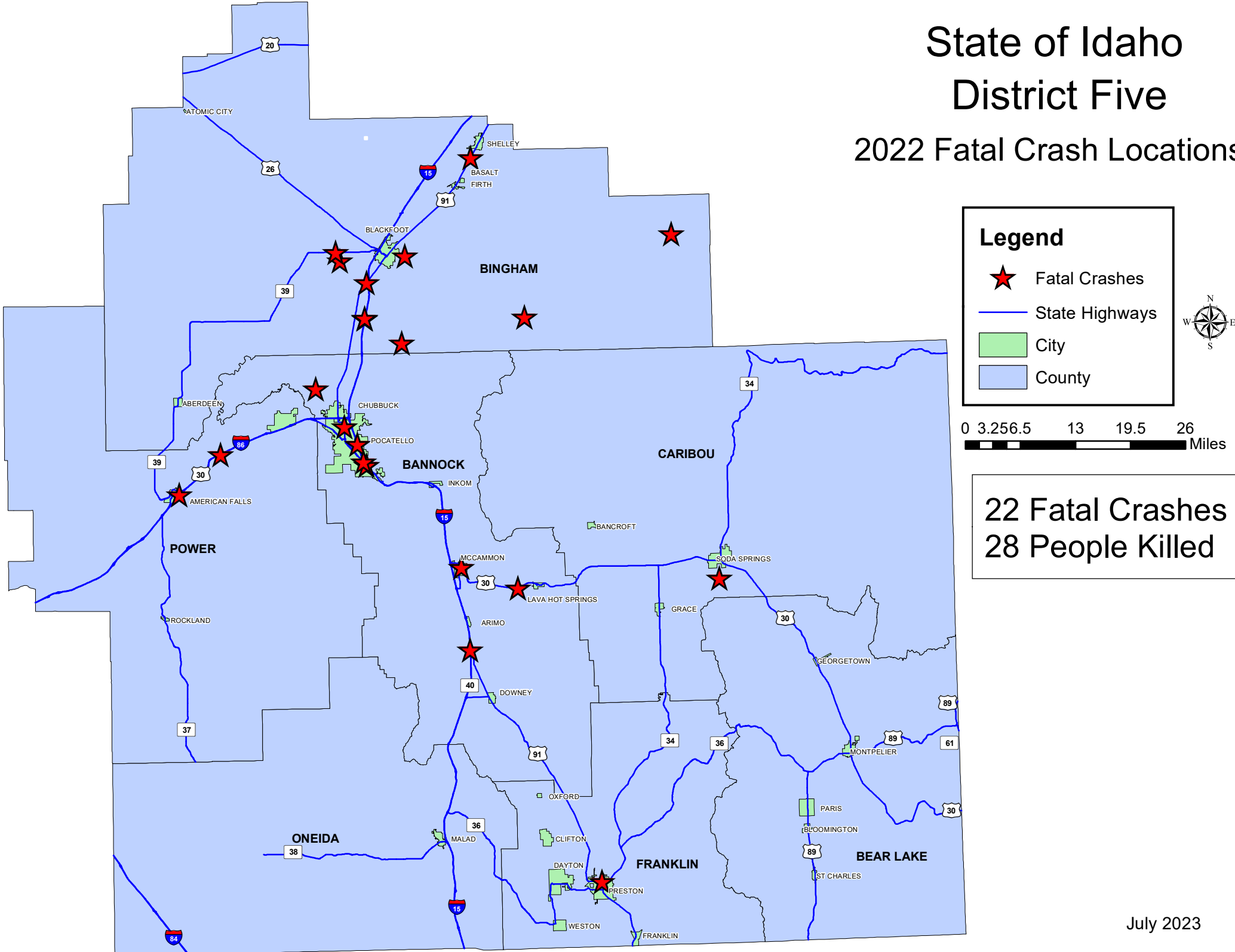
