The attached table includes 22 projects being added to the STIP to accommodate, in part, the additional funding Idaho has received. All project actions were approved by the Idaho Transportation Board at their May 19, 2021 meeting. The Kootenai Metropolitan Planning Organization updated their Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) with Amendment #11 on June 4, 2021 and the Bonneville Metropolitan Planning Organization updated their TIP with Amendment #2 on May 20, 2021.

The table includes four projects being advanced into the current fiscal year and funded with Federal COVID funds. The second group of projects are all State funded and therefore, being added for your information only. Additional projects are being prepared by the districts and will be submitted in the near future. The Department requests that all actions included in this request be amended to the FY 2021 – 2027 STIP so that funds may be obligated as planned.

No further public involvement or air quality conformity analysis is required. The Idaho Transportation Department certifies that the above actions meet all applicable requirements as described in 23 CFR 450.218 of *Planning Assistance and Standards*. The STIP continues to be consistent with the Idaho Transportation Department's 2040 Long-Range Transportation Plan as approved by the Idaho Transportation Board in 2019.
