This amendment approval amends the 2022 STIP to reflect updated project costs for four projects (KN22165, KN23409, KN23409, KN23410) and the addition of KN 23608, as requested in ITD's April 20, 2022 letter. This approval is based on the following:

- The changes to the program is not intermodal in nature and will not affect the State's conformity process and, therefore, FHWA has sole approval authority.

This amendment request is for significant cost changes to four existing projects and the addition of one project, all of which are funded with TECM Bonding. It does not affect the fiscal constraint of the STIP, as the funding was unexpected. The Community Planning Association of Southwest Idaho updated their Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) with Administrative Modification #3 on April 12, 2022; and Administrative Modification #10 on April 19, 2022. And, the Bannock Transportation Planning Organization updated their TIP with Amendment #4 on April 8, 2022.

The Department requests that all project changes described in this letter be amended to the FY 2022 – 2028 STIP in order to allow obligation of funds as planned.

No further public involvement or air quality conformity analysis is required. The Idaho Transportation Department certifies that the above actions meet all applicable requirements as described in 23 CFR 450.218 of *Planning Assistance and Standards*. The STIP continues to be consistent with the Idaho Transportation Department's 2040 Long-Range Transportation Plan as approved by the Idaho Transportation Board in 2019.
