Dear Mr. Stokes:

This approval amends the 2023 STIP to include two new projects and to decrease costs in one project, as requested in ITD's February 29, 2023 letter. This approval is based on the following:

- The changes to the program are not intermodal in nature and will not affect the State's conformity process and, therefore, FHWA has sole approval authority.
- ITD certifies they have the mechanisms in place to ensure compliance with new rules required by the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law and this request maintains fiscal constraint.
- ITD is demonstrating progress toward addressing the corrective actions noted in the 2023 Federal Finding.
- This action does not serve as an eligibility determination of approval of Federal participation as some programs may have additional program requirements (e.g. the National Highway Freight Program)

In consideration of the above, ITD's 2023 STIP Amendment #H1 is approved as requested.

The attached list includes 3 projects. One project is being added in response to the awarding of a federally funded grant, while the other two are offsetting actions for a budgetary increase/decrease. The added project has preliminary engineering, right of way, or construction costs scheduled in FY 2023. These development costs are needed in FY 2023 so the project can be started as soon as possible, so it was added as opposed to advancing existing STIP projects forward.

The Metropolitan Planning Organizations involved with these projects updated their individual Transportation Improvement Programs as follows: Community Planning Association of Southwest Idaho – 10/17/22.

A public comment period was held 2/7/23 – 2/16/23 for items requiring public involvement, and comments were shared with IT Board members for consideration.

The Department requests that the addition of and changes to these projects be amended to the FY 2023 – 2029 STIP so that funds may be obligated as planned.

No further public involvement or air quality conformity analysis is required. The Idaho Transportation Department certifies that the above actions meet all applicable requirements as described in 23 CFR 450.218 of *Planning Assistance and Standards*. The STIP continues to be consistent with the Idaho Transportation Department's 2040 Long-Range Transportation Plan as approved by the Idaho Transportation Board in 2019.
