Dear Mr. Stokes:

This approval amends the 2023 STIP to add one project recently awarded funding through the National Scenic Byway program, as requested in the attached ITD September 22, 2023, letter. This approval is based on the following:

- The changes to the program are not intermodal in nature and will not affect the State's conformity process and, therefore, FHWA has sole approval authority
- ITD certifies they have the mechanisms in place to ensure compliance with new rules required by the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law
- The project was selected for funded though the National Scenic Byway Program and therefore, the state maintains fiscal constraint
- ITD continues to demonstrate progress toward addressing the corrective actions noted in the 2023 Federal Finding
- This action does not serve as an eligibility determination of approval of Federal participation as some programs may have additional program requirements

In consideration of the above, ITD's 2023 STIP Amendment #H9 is approved, as requested.
