Dear Mr. Stokes:

This approval amends the 2024 STIP to revise the bridge restoration grouped totals and add one project as requested in the attached letter dated March 13, 2024. This approval is based on the following:

- The changes to the program are not intermodal in nature and will not affect the State's conformity process; therefore, FHWA has sole approval authority,
- ITD certifies they have the mechanisms in place to ensure compliance with new rules required by the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law,
- The funding projections were lower than anticipated and funds are available for the projects; therefore, the state maintains constraint,
- ITD continues to demonstrate progress toward addressing the corrective actions noted in the 2024 Federal Finding, and
- This action does not serve as an eligibility determination of approval of Federal participation as some programs may have additional program requirements.

In consideration of the above, ITD's 2024 STIP Amendment #H1 is approved as requested.

### Dear Mr. Hartman:

The attached list consists of four projects, three of which are grouped and companioned. The grouped projects are adding a total cost increase of \$7M to the Bridge Restoration program. KN 24394 is a consolidation of the design of previously obligated pavement restoration projects (23212 / 23238 / 23244 / 24149) totaling \$690k and is being added to the program with PC costs increased by \$2M. FY24 is currently under-programmed by approximately \$17M from Statewide Balancing actions, which allow these actions to maintain fiscal constraint of the STIP. Furthermore, these projects have preliminary engineering, right of way, or construction costs scheduled in FY24; These development costs are needed in FY24 so the projects can be started as soon as possible, so they were added as opposed to advancing existing STIP projects forward.

The Department requests that these projects be amended to the FY 2024 - 2030 STIP so that funds may be obligated as planned.

No further public involvement or air quality conformity analysis is required. The Idaho Transportation Department certifies that the above actions meet all applicable requirements as described in 23 CFR 450.218 of *Planning Assistance and Standards*. The STIP continues to be consistent with the Idaho Transportation Department's 2040 Long-Range Transportation Plan as approved by the Idaho Transportation Board in 2019.
