This approval amends the 2024 STIP as requested in the attached letter dated March 28, 2024. This approval is based on the following:

- The changes to the program are not intermodal in nature and will not affect the State's conformity process; therefore, FHWA has sole approval authority,
- ITD certifies they have the mechanisms in place to ensure compliance with new rules required by the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law,
 - ITD certifies that funds are available for the projects; therefore, the state maintains constraint,
- ITD continues to demonstrate progress toward addressing the corrective actions noted in the 2024 Federal Finding, and
- This action does not serve as an eligibility determination of approval of Federal participation as some programs may have additional program requirements.

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In consideration of the above, ITD's 2024 STIP Amendment #H2 is approved as requested.

Dear Mr. Hartman:

The attached list consists of two projects. KN 20383 is increasing construction costs with an offsetting amount coming from KN 20207. KN 24378 is being added to the STIP so funds can be obligated as scheduled. This offset is from \$6M under-programming in FY24. NHPP funds will be used for the obligation, which are available due to ITD's strategy of using the most restrictive eligible funding source first for all obligations. These actions maintain fiscal constraint of the STIP. Furthermore, these projects have preliminary engineering, right of way, or construction costs scheduled in FY24; These development costs are needed in FY24 so the projects can be started as soon as possible, so they were added as opposed to advancing existing STIP projects forward.

The projects in this Amendment were included in the 3/18/24 - 3/27/24 public comment period, with no comments being received to share with IT Board members for consideration.

The Department requests that these projects be amended to the FY 2024 – 2030 STIP so that funds may be obligated as planned.

No further public involvement or air quality conformity analysis is required. The Idaho Transportation Department certifies that the above actions meet all applicable requirements as described in 23 CFR 450.218 of *Planning Assistance and Standards*. The STIP continues to be consistent with the Idaho Transportation Department's 2040 Long-Range Transportation Plan as approved by the Idaho Transportation Board in 2019.
