SUBJECT: 2022 5010-1 Airport Inspection conducted May 17, 2022.
(04308.65*A Rockford Rockford Municipal Airport)

Scott,

On May 17, 2022, I visited the airport to conduct the FAA 5010-1 Airport Safety Data Inspection. These inspections are performed under contract with the FAA on a three-year cycle. The completed process updates the Airport Master Record (FAA Form 5010-1) and several connected publications supporting the FAA and the National Airspace System (NAS). I have summarized the inspection findings below:

Runway (16-34): The runway surface continues to remain in good condition. Pavement shows good integrity and very few and small, insignificant cracks. Surface is solid but rough due to exposed small, aggregate rocks. The runway markings are fair to poor - both the numbers and the centerline need new paint to make them more visible from the air. Controlling obstructions for each runway end remain the same, they have not changed.

Taxiway/Ramp/Tiedowns: There is no taxiway at this facility. The ramp and tie down area near the hangar, at rwy end 16, I found to be in good condition. Overall, there are 9 parking spots (3 on pavement and 6 on the grass); only the 3 on pavement had chains and good markings. Grass parking is not very obvious to pilots unfamiliar with the airfield, so a couple of signs indicating where the tie-down area in the grass is, would be helpful.

Windsock/Standard: I found the windsock to be in good condition with no fading, rips or tears. The metal standard is in good working order and has red/white paint – some of it is flaking off. There was no segmented circle present around the standard.

Lighting: N/A; this facility is day VFR only.

Miscellaneous/Services: Overall, the airport is decent, well maintained and has good vegetation control. I saw no other new safety concerns or hazards that need to be addressed. If you have any questions or concerns, please call me and we can chat. Have a great day.
