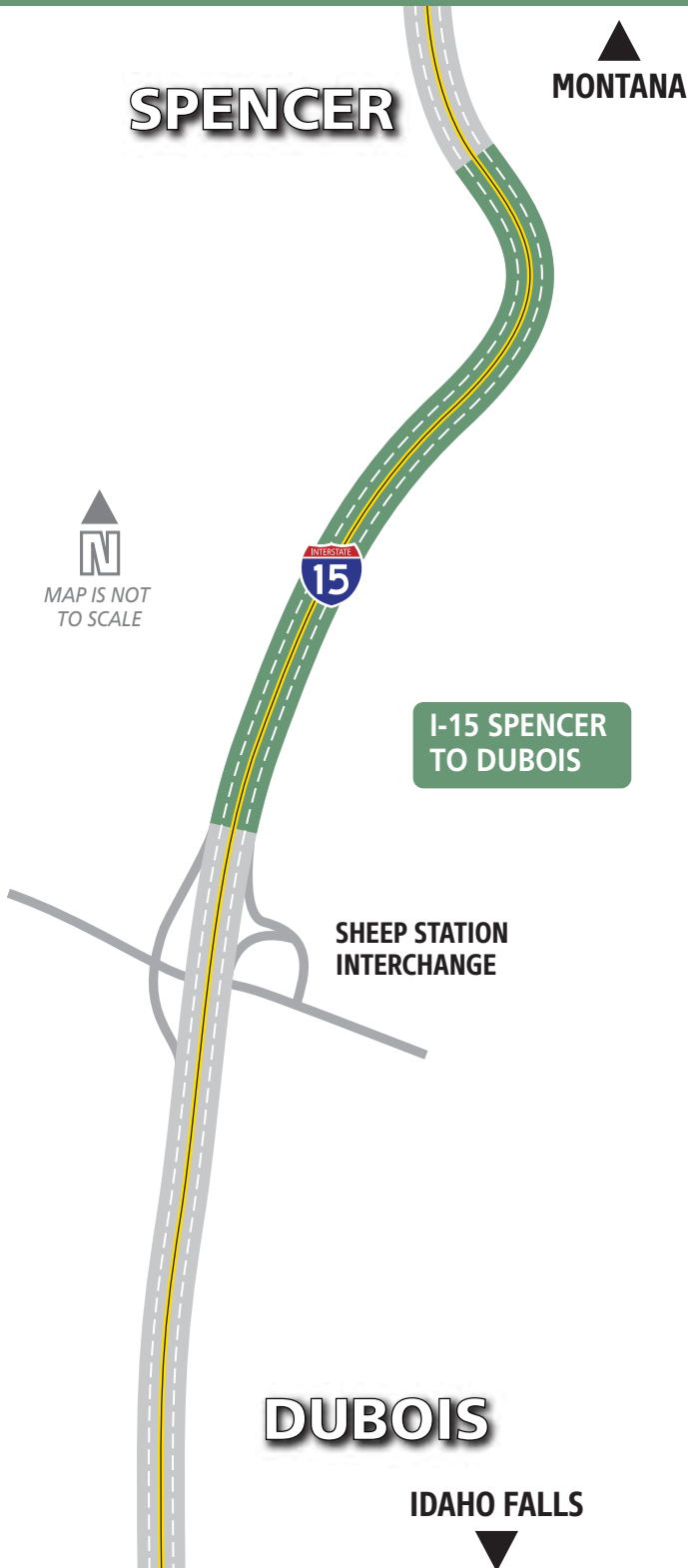


I-15 SPENCER TO DUBOIS RECONSTRUCTION EARLY MAY TO OCTOBER



The Idaho Transportation Department will reconstruct 8.3 miles of Interstate 15 between the towns of Spencer and Dubois in southeast Idaho. Moisture accumulation and thawing has resulted in deterioration of the pavement and supportive base layers beneath the interstate.

Work in 2018 will include:

- Removal of existing pavement, and adding a drainable base layer on top of existing sub-layers.
- Resurfacing the pavement to provide a new smooth surface.
- Improving the shoulders and edge drains.
- Replacing rumble strips and upgrading guardrail.

Traffic impacts:

- Both north- and southbound traffic will travel on the same side of I-15.
- The speed limit will be reduced.
- Crews will work six days a week.
