SUBJECT: Employee Service Awards

Beginning July 1, 2009, DHR will send the agencies certificates of service signed by the Governor for those employees reaching a service milestone. In addition, employees with 20 years or more of state service will receive a letter from the Governor.

Please note that service award gifts may not be purchased using agency funds.
