- Veterans Services- Kevin Wallior discussed the Veterans Homeless Park on State Street. Need for a public transportation Corridor. Discussion on BRT increasing along State Street. ACHD, VRT and ITD are in partnership with efforts. Money not currently identified. Terri Lindenberg mentioned that VRT was holding an open

house at Main Street Station where people could get additional information.

- Commerce- Eric Forsch discussed the Affordable Housing White Paper. This white paper includes state-wide options, tools, etc. Unemployment very low, companies are raising wages to keep employees. Difficulty for companies to hire and retain employees. Currently discussing a project on housing and transportation data: where are people moving to?
- CTAI- Terri Lindenberg discussed that CTAI was working with CTAA's Chris Zellinger to help with the direction of the group. Efforts are still moving forward.
- Health & Welfare-Dori Boyle stated that MTM made changes to the billing system and how providers submit data. This change made things easier and went really well. H&W is also having 1:1 meetings with providers without MTM. D1&2 and D6&7. Still having feedback from riders about not getting to appointments. Lack of resources and drivers for requests.
