# Rural Opportunities to Use Transportation for Economic Success (ROUTES)



The Rural Opportunities to Use Transportation for Economic Success (ROUTES) Initiative prioritizes the needs of rural America by advancing rural transportation policy and supporting rural and Tribal communities that face challenges relating to transportation safety, mobility, and economic development. The ROUTES Initiative addresses the transportation infrastructure needs of rural communities by developing user-friendly tools and information, aggregating DOT resources, and providing direct technical assistance to better connect rural communities with the funding, financing, and outreach resources available.

# DOT Competitive Grants Dashboard

The DOT Competitive Grants Dashboard provides communities with an overview of competitive grant opportunities that can help meet their transportation infrastructure needs. Designed with all communities in mind, the Dashboard identifies grant programs with rural and Tribal set-asides or match waivers available. The Dashboard also includes Federal grant programs outside of DOT that may be of particular interest to [rural communities](#). The Dashboard is updated weekly.

### Helpful information to report:

- Description of car(s) (make, model, color, license plate number, etc.)
- Description of people (height, weight, hair color, eye color, age, distinguishing marks, etc.)
- If it is safe to do so, a picture.
- When did you see the event in question take place? What day was it?
- Address and location(s) where suspicious activity took place.

### Trafficking **Red Flags** to Look for:

- Restricted or controlled communication
- Disheveled appearance, unkempt, alone, scared/crying
- Behavioral changes
- Disorientation, confused, signs of mental/physical abuse
- Bruising, scratch marks, bites marks, fractured bones, scalp abrasions
- Offers to exchange sex for a ride, meal, etc.
- Doesn't know the person picking them up
- Acknowledgment that they have a pimp or making a quota
- Signs of branding or tattooing

Warning: Please do not approach traffickers. Call the hotline, and if instructed, the local police (911). Allow law enforcement to deal with traffickers and recover victims. Approaching traffickers is not only dangerous for you and their victims but could lead to problems in the eventual prosecution of traffickers. Also, please notify your manager of suspicious activity.
