They have caregiving in the form of homemaker services, personal-care services and respite services.

Transportation services provides rides to and from the Senior Connection Mondays through Fridays. The bus was acquired through an ITD-PT grant and is booked 48 hours in advance. They have a relationship with Mountain Rides, which can deviate to the Senior Connection with two-hour advance notice.
