Southern Teton Area Rapid Transit (START) is a public bus service providing rides Monday-Friday from Star Valley, Wyoming and Teton Valley, Idaho to Jackson, Wyoming. The commuter service is convenient and affordable and a safe way for employees who live outside of Jackson to get to work.

The START system was first implemented to be the skier's transportation from the town to Teton Village. It has been in operation from 1987.

Since then, START has implemented a bus service for visitors and locals in Jackson that runs all year round. This is a free service to the community provided the trip starts or ends within Jackson town limits.

START has an on-demand service that provides free rides around the town of Jackson. You can download the START on-demand app or call in to request a ride at 307.733.4521.
