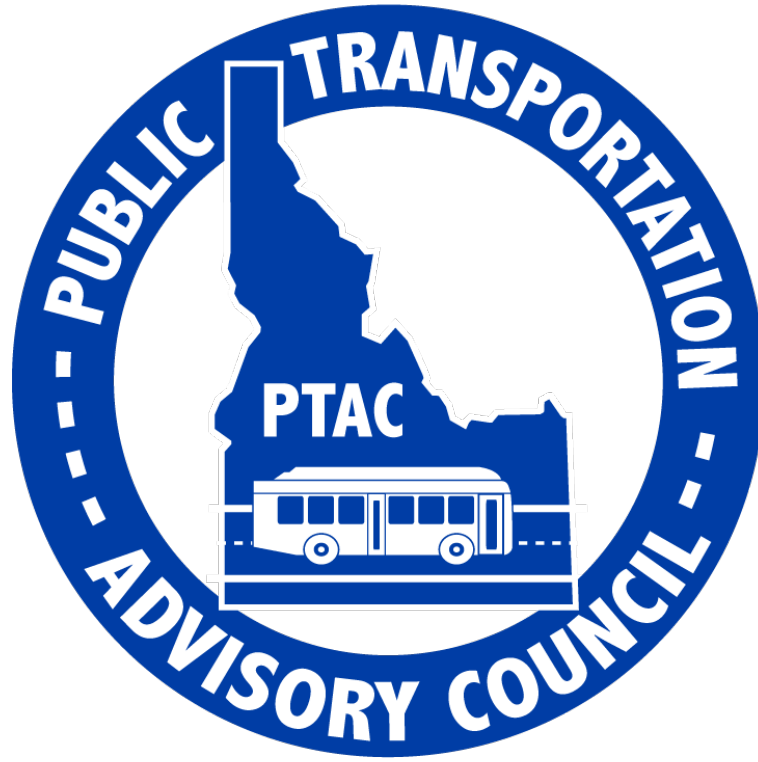

Designation/Authority

- Idaho Code 40-514
- Idaho Transportation Board Policy 4039
- PTAC Charter

Purpose

- Advise ITD on issues and policies regarding public transportation in Idaho
- Participate in planning activities
- Identify transportation needs
- Promote coordinated transportation systems
- Ensure the ITD-PT programs is safe, financially sustainable within the current funding constraints, and is capable of appropriately adjusting to the changing transportation landscape.



Composition

- 6 Members appointed by the Idaho Transportation Board
- Shall be representatives of local governments and agencies, private organizations, citizen groups and private providers that have an interest in public transportation, and people with disabilities and the elderly who utilize public transportation.
- 1 member for each ITD District
- 3 year term (July 1 – June 30)
- 2 representatives renewed each year



Application

- Coordinated by ITD-PT
- Open at minimum 30 calendar days
- 30 day Public Comment Period
- PTAC review
- Idaho Transportation Board Appointment
- No automatic renewal

Public Transportation Advisory and Working Groups

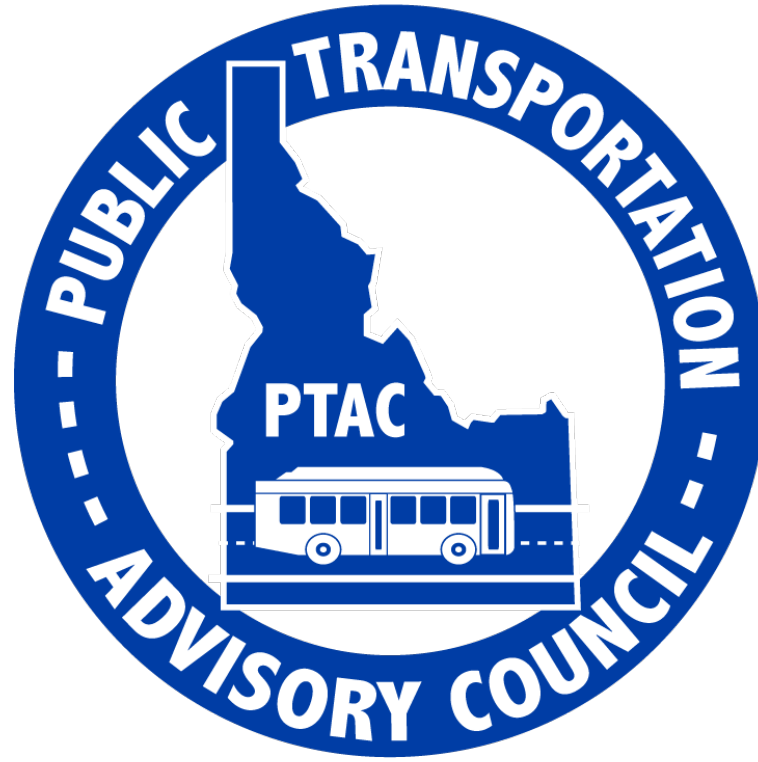

The IWG is made up of representing government agencies that have a role in public transportation in Idaho. The PTAC has six members appointed by the Idaho Transportation Department Board and advises the Department on issues and policies regarding public transportation.
