

Background

The U.S. 20/26 corridor is one of the few east-west commuter routes that connects Boise to Caldwell. The majority of U.S. 20/26 is a two lane and three lane rural highway between Boise and Caldwell. As the land around the roadway develops, U.S. 20/26 is becoming a busy urban corridor in many locations.

The land use along the roadway is mainly agricultural, but an increasing number of residential subdivisions and commercial development are being constructed. The future is expected to bring a variety of development that will transform U.S. 20/26 into an urban corridor.

ITD is working cooperatively with cities and Ada and Canyon counties to keep U.S. 20/26 functioning as a safe, primary east-west route in the future. ITD is seeking input from all stakeholders, including property owners and motorists.
